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Spring Orientation Registration Checklist

STEP 1 **CHECK** your Registration Information Sheet (RIS) at <https://utdirect.utexas.edu/registrar/ris.WBX>. Make sure you do not have any bars that would prevent your registration.

STEP 2 Make sure you have **SUBMITTED** proof that you have met the meningococcal (bacterial meningitis) vaccine requirement to University Health Services (UHS). International students have additional medical clearance requirements. For more information, visit healthyhorns.utexas.edu/requiredvaccine/.

STEP 3 **ATTEND** your College Meeting and receive your advising appointment.

STEP 4 Before meeting with your academic advisor, **FAMILIARIZE** yourself with the Spring 2018 Course Schedule and the 2016–2018 Undergraduate Catalog by visiting the Registrar's website at registrar.utexas.edu.

STEP 5 **MEET WITH** your academic advisor for course approval, if required by your college. Your Registration Information Sheet (RIS) at utdirect.utexas.edu/registrar/ris.WBX will inform you if you need to be advised.

STEP 6 **ATTEND** one required UTransform Session.

STEP 7 From Jan. 9–12, **REGISTER** for classes online during your scheduled access period. You can find the registration link at my.utexas.edu. Orientation Advisors and academic advisors will be available to help with registration from 9:30–11 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 9 in the Flawn Academic Center (FAC), unless another location was specified by your college.

STEP 8 **PAY** your tuition and fee bill by 5 p.m. on Jan. 12 or your registration will be canceled. Detailed information on payment options is available at tuition.utexas.edu/pay.

STEP 9 If you must **MAKE CHANGES** to your class schedule, the official add/drop period runs through Friday, Jan. 19 at 5 p.m. Payment for added classes is due by 5 p.m. on Jan. 31.

Class registration will begin at 10 a.m. on Jan. 9 at my.utexas.edu. Tuition bills are due by 5 p.m. on Jan. 12 for undergraduate students who have registered but not paid.
